

Leland Grove Updates

We would like to thank the residents of Leland Grove for their patience and understanding as we move through the clean-up of the June 29th storm. Kudos to the street crew and the police department who have worked endless hours to make sure the streets are safe for our residents.

At this time the street crew will begin the arduous task of mulching and removing the tree debris. The following procedure will be followed:

- **July 10th - Small Limb & Branch Piles complying with City Ordinance #368**

Street department crew will resume picking up small limb & branch piles. Pickup will continue from the East to West portions of Leland Grove. This will take place the week of July 10th.

- **July 17th - Large Limb & Branch Piles**

Street department crew will be working with **Browns Storm Service** to remove larger limbs and branch piles, if branches were not picked up during the week of July 10th. Most likely they will be picked up during the week of July 17th. Vehicles blocking access to the branch piles will be skipped. Due to the large volume to be collected, the City will not return for blocked piles.

- During the Limb & Branch Collection - leaves, grass clippings, weeds, and other yard waste will not be collected. **Stickers will be required from your waste hauler for these items.**
- Door hangers will be provided for skipped limb & branch piles explaining reason it was missed. **Branch piles or whole trees placed in right-of-way by contractors or tree services will not be picked up.**

Ordinance #368

The tree limbs and branches must be located on the city right of way directly in front of the resident's home but shall not be located on the pavement portion of any street.

Tree limbs and branches must be:

- Less than two inches (2") in diameter and six feet (6') in length.
- Free of any root ball.
- Branches and tree limbs must be placed in a residential sized garbage/trash receptacle.
Larger amounts may be placed in one pile no more than six feet (6') long by six feet (6') wide by six feet (6') tall. The homeowner must perform all work associated with tree limbs and branches.

The following items will **not be eligible** for the pick-up program:

- Leaves, grass clippings, weeds, and other yard waste.
- Whole bushes, vines and hedge trimmings.
- Compost material.
- Roots and root balls.
- Tree limbs larger than eight inches (8") in diameter.
- Whole trees.
- Any nonorganic matter, e.g. paper and plastic bags.
- Materials from commercial workers are not eligible for the City's monthly pickup.
