    - 9-3-10: Intensity of Use: to limit the coverage of a front or corner side yard to no more than 50% impermeable surface, hard permeable surface, or a combination of the two.
    - 9-3-13: Accessory Buildings: to allow accessory buildings on narrow corner lots (50' lots in the eastern part of Ward I) to use the setback from the side street of the principal building rather than the front yard setback.
    - 9-4-2: Damaged Structures: to allow a damaged or destroyed garage on a narrow lot to be rebuilt on the original footprint and to its original height without conforming to current setback requirements. That is currently allowed for single-family dwellings, but not garages.
